Every class offered herein is covered by the rules and specifications of the current rules of EC and will be held and judged in accordance with the EC Rule Book. (A602.2)

EQUESTRIAN CANADA STATEMENT OF PRINCIPLE

Equestrian Canada (EC), the national equestrian federation of Canada, supports adherence to humane treatment of horses in all competitions under its jurisdiction.

EC is committed to

- Upholding the welfare of horses, regardless of value, as a primary consideration in all activities;
- Requiring that horses be treated with kindness, respect, and the compassion that they deserve, and that they never be subjected to mistreatment;
- Ensuring that owners, trainers and exhibitors or their agents use responsible care in the handling, treatment and transportation of their horses as well as horses placed in their care for any purpose;
- Providing for the continuous well-being of horses by encouraging routine inspection and consultation with health care professionals and competition officials to achieve the highest possible standards of nutrition, health, comfort, sanitation and safety as a matter of standard operating procedure;
- Continuing to support scientific studies on equine health and welfare;
- Increasing education in training and horsemanship practices;
- Requiring owners, trainers and exhibitors to know and follow their sanctioning organization's rules, and to work within industry regulations in all equestrian competition;
- Reviewing, revising and developing competition rules and regulations that protect the welfare of horses.

The standard by which conduct or treatment will be measured is that which a reasonable person, informed and experienced in generally accepted equine training and exhibition procedures, would determine to be neither cruel, abusive nor inhumane.

Equestrian Canada Regulations

Any horse entered in any class at a competition may be selected for equine medication control testing while at the event location. (A602.5)

"Per Article A801, every entry at an EC sanctioned competition shall constitute an agreement by the person responsible that the owner, lessee, trainer, manager, agent, coach, driver, or rider and horse shall be subject to the EC Constitution and all rules of EC and any additional rules set by the competition. It is the responsibility of all individuals participating in any capacity in EC sanctioned competitions to be knowledgeable regarding the EC constitution and the applicable rules of EC and the additional rule, if any, imposed by the competition. (A602.7)

Do not participate in this EC sanctioned competition if you do not consent to be bound by the constitution and rules of EC and any additional rules imposed by the competition." (A602.7)

AHA Membership Statement

Each competitor (this includes at least one recorded owner and ALL trainers, drivers, riders, halter handlers, coaches and the person(s) signing the entry blank) in an Arabian Horse Association Recognized Arabian Division, at the time of entry into competition, must submit a copy of a valid AHA Membership Competition card, Join AHA or pay an AHA Single Event Membership fee PER competitor. Note that AHA Single Event Memberships are not accepted at ECA Breeders or Regional Shows- full competition membership must be held by above listed parties.

When an agent signs for the owner at an AHA recognized competition, both the owner and agent must be members of AHA or pay the AHA Single Event Membership (if applicable).

Single Event membership is not acceptable at AHA Regional or National Competitions.

Exhibitors in Walk-Trot classes are exempt from AHA membership requirements at qualifying competitions, but must have an AHA membership with Competition card at AHA Regional and National Competitions.

Exhibitors in Lead Line classes or Parents/Guardians signing for minors are exempt from AHA membership requirements.

ALL HORSES MUST HAVE BEEN VACCINATED FOR FLU/RHINO(1&4) no more than 6 months and no less than 7 days prior to arrival at show. Competition management may request supporting documentation confirming a horse's compliance with mandatory vaccination requirements and horses not in compliance may be asked to leave the event site.

"All horses attending Equestrian Canada sanctioned competitions must have met the requirements of Article A519, Vaccinations. See Rules of Equestrian Canada, Section A, General Regulations, Article A519, Vaccinations."

"When registering for EC sanctioned competitions, athletes must indicate the name of their coach on the entry form or specify that they are self-coached.

Coaches from other countries, must be in good-standing with their home federation and must declare/have proof of insurance. See Rules of Equestrian Canada, Section A, General Regulations, Article 102, Safe Sport Environments."

SHOW INFORMATION- please read!

SHOW OFFICE OFFICE The office will be open Wednesday July 19 from 11:00 am to 9:00 p.m. The Show Secretary hours will be open from Wednesday July 19 from 12:00pm to the conclusion of the Eastern Canadian Breeders Show. The hours for the remaining days will be posted at the office but will be at least one-half hour prior to the start of classes, to the end of the last class each day. Exhibitors are requested to report to the show office as soon as possible after arrival, to pick up show packets, correct any pending items or make entries. **It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to review and confirm their entry paperwork before leaving the show office, as any class changes made after that point will be considered post entries.**

* **LOCATION** Ancaster Fairgrounds are located at 630 Trinity Rd S, Jerseyville, ON L0R1R0. Exit Highway 403 at **Copetown Exit #55**, head South on Route 52/Trinity Rd. All trailers to enter Gate #3. No Access to stabling from Gates 1 & 2.

ENTRIES

1. All entries are to **be received by June 30th, 2023 for all horses.** Any entry received after this date will be billed the appropriate POST ENTRY FEES- refer to Fee Schedule- except for Dressage, where every entry must be received by July 4th to allow for scheduling. If you intend to qualify at the Last Chance Show, please submit the completed Region 18 entry form with classes selected. You will receive a refund for classes you do not achieve the required qualifications for.

2. Entries must be submitted on the Official Entry Form for the show, which may be duplicated. **Entries will not be processed without a payment, and open cheques will be processed in the proper amount and deposited when received. SINGLE ITEM FEES (SUCH AS STALLS, SPONSORSHIPS, etc.) CANNOT BE SPLIT** Note that some items are charged per show, but Stalls are only once per horse. Please read and complete the entry form carefully. Hors Concours entries are not accepted at this show.

3. Waivers- One waiver form must be completed for EACH show entered and must be signed by all required parties. Juniors CANNOT sign waivers, and there must be an address provided for each Junior.

*CHEQUES COVERING MORE THAN ONE ENTRY are to be accompanied by a detailed description of how the money is to be applied.

*Each competitor is responsible for supplying management with correct association numbers (USEF, EC, AHA) for horse, owner, rider, and trainer, before the day(s) of the competition. The scores of competitors who fail to supply correct numbers may not be counted toward National awards.

***BACK NUMBERS WILL NOT BE RELEASED UNTIL ALL REQUIRED INFORMATION IS PROVIDED TO THE SHOW OFFICE AND PAYMENT FOR CLASSES HAS BEEN MADE.**

*There will be a \$100.00 fee for each returned cheque.

*Refunds on fees will be made upon request with a written statement from your Veterinarian on said Veterinarian's letterhead, **if received by July 5, 2023.** NO REFUNDS on stalls after July 5, 2023. Office fees are non-refundable; AHA Res 9-90 and AHA results fees

REGIONAL QUALIFICATION * ******

Regional qualifications have been CONTINUED for 2023. Refer to AHA Qualification Chart to ensure you are qualified. Please refer to AHA Handbook Chapter 14 for requirements for 2023 Regionals, as well as any National shows.

Also, please note that per AHA Chapter 14 Qual 102.7 "Placings in Regionals/Canadian Breeders/East Coast or Pacific Slope Championships do not qualify a horse for Regional Championships." To be shown in an ATR/H/D class, the horse must be qualified by an Amateur. Refer to AHA Article 101.16- "It is the responsibility of the person(s) signing the Entry Form to verify that the horse is eligible and verified to compete in the respective Regional Championship class(es)."

REGISTRATION REQUIREMENTS Horses shown at these shows must have been issued a certificate of registration from the Canadian Horse Registry and/or the Arabian Horse Registry of America or if under one year of age be eligible for registration and registration applied for, and must be entered in their full registered name. Only weanlings that have had registration applied for may show without registration papers. A copy of the registration papers showing proof of ownership must be submitted with the entry form at the time of making entries. In the case of a sale or lease, it is required that a contract of the sale or lease, or statement from the owner be submitted with the copy of the registration papers.

Horses shown in the Half/Anglo Arabian Division must have been issued a Registration certificate from CPAR or AHA or be eligible for registration if under one year of age. Half-Arabian colts/stallions two years and older may not compete in Half-Arabian/Anglo Arabian breeding line classes.

HORSE HEALTH REQUIREMENTS Current health certificates are required for all horses coming from the United States into Canada. Please check with your veterinarian regarding border crossing regulations (i.e., Negative EIA/Coggins test). EC now requires all horses to have been vaccinated for EHV 1 & 4 prior to admittance to grounds. Refer to EC Rules, Section A Article 514.

excluded. 75% of class entry fees will be refunded on receipt of a veterinarian certificate following the close of entries, but prior to your classes. Exhibitors must notify the Show Secretary of cancellations prior to the time the class is called.

SAFE SPORT All competitive athletes, owners, and officials are required to complete two EC Safe Sport training sessions, **EC Concussion Awareness and Fostering Healthy Environments** found in the ECampus within your MyEC account. The training courses are provided FREE of charge to all sport license holders. Coaches have safe sport training as part of their status program certification.

AMATEUR STATUS Every person who has reached his/her 19th birthday and competes in classes for amateurs under EC rules must possess current amateur certification issued by Equestrian Canada or equivalent USEF certification if USEF member.

*Junior/Amateur age will be determined as of December 1 of the previous year for the purposes of AHA youth classes. All adults are determined as of December 1 in accordance with EC Arabian rules B1402.10.

RECIPROCITY EC Sport License holders / USEF membership status is recognized by each of the U.S. and Canada under an agreement between the Federations. This agreement pertains to rule infractions **Residents of Canada MUST be a member of Equestrian Canada.** EC rules take precedence.

TBA Classes TBA classes may be any class on the AHA class list apart from Working Cow, Obstacle driving, Marathon, Combined Driving, Driven Dressage, Endurance, Competitive Trail, Racing, Barrels, Poles, or other classes we do not have access to materials or proper facilities needed to run. TBA's are awarded on a first come first serve basis, must be reserved with the show secretary, must be approved by the show committee, and must be paid for in advance of show. Show management reserves the right to allocate the TBA slots in a manner to facilitate the show. Payment of \$25 CAD (\$19 USD) is required in addition to the set class entry fee.

STABLE AREA

ARRIVAL AND DEPARTURE TIMES

Stalls are available Wednesday July 19 beginning at 11am and must be vacated by Saturday July 22 at 1159 pm (discuss with Joshua Schildroth for other arrangements).

STABLING is limited and will not be allocated unless stalls have been **PAID FOR IN FULL** and **STABLING FORMS** submitted to the Show Secretary-No postdated cheques. Stalls are assigned as stall fees are paid. Early entry is an advantage for stabling assignment. Exhibitors wishing to stable together must send their entries in the same envelope.

Anyone found using stalls that were not assigned to them by the stabling managers will be subject to penalty, and possible ejection from grounds. NO REFUNDS on stalls after June 30, 2023. Each exhibitor is responsible for the cleanliness of his/her aisle.

Stalls must not be altered by removal of panels. You will be billed for any damage due to screws, tape, etc.

*HORSES MUST BE BATHED IN DESIGNATED WASH STALL AREAS. There are both indoor and outdoor wash racks, but hot water is limited.

*SHAVINGS Will be available at current market price. Please order by the closing date to ensure availability.

*Manure disposal is provided for in designated areas.

GENERAL

ADMISSION TO ARENA No person will be permitted to enter the arena except class participants, judges, and their assistants, show photographers and show management personnel. Attendants will not be permitted in arena until summoned by order of the judge.

ASTM/SEI HEADGEAR Properly fitting protective headgear meeting ASTM/SEI standards must be worn, with harness secured, by the following: 1) All juniors riding in Hunt Seat Equitation sections; 2) All juniors riding on competition grounds, *unless* exempted for the class in which they are competing at that time; All juniors must also always wear footwear with appropriate heel when riding.

CALL FOR CLASSES The two-minute rule will be STRICTLY ENFORCED. Only when a horse or rider/diver/handler has back-to-back classes will a 3-minute tack hold be granted if requested before the end of the preceding session. All tack changes must be made at the entrance gate to the arena.

CAMPERS There are **hydro hook ups available with 15-, 30- or 50-amp** service. No Water connection, so come prepared. There is a hose on the grounds which can be used to top up. No pump out. First paid, first reserved. Camper plate number is required before entries will be released. Verification tickets will be provided when entries are picked up and **must be visibly displayed**. YOU WILL BE ASSIGNED TO A LOCATION. CAMPERS MUST NOT BE PLUGGED INTO ANY OF THE BARN HYDRO OUTLETS OR TO ANOTHER CAMPER HOOKED UP TO HYDRO. NO CAMPING IN TENTS PERMITTED FOR SAFETY REASONS.

CONDUCT Exhibitors are hereby notified that any act of discourtesy or disobedience to Judges, Officials and/or Show Staff on the part of the owner, trainer, rider, or any other attendant, shall be grounds to disqualify the horse, and all entry fees and other charges and prize money won shall be forfeited. The Show Committee also bears the responsibility to aid the judges in avoiding contact with exhibitors or their agents before and during the show.

Horses shall not be punished unnecessarily or severely. No excessive whipping will be tolerated. Horses must always be treated with respect.

DIVISION/COMBINING/RESTRICTION OF CLASSES Classes may be split or combined at the discretion of show management. Management reserves the right to split any class for safety purposes. Management reserves the right to limit entries if required.

DOGS All dogs must always be on leashes and not allowed in the show arena complex. Stoop and Scoop in effect- fines applicable for non-compliance.

DRUG TESTING Any horse entered in any class at a competition subject to the requirement to pay drug testing fees may, while on the competition grounds and may be selected for equine medication control testing.

FOOTING 120'x 285' main indoor arena is sand, indoor warm up is 100'X220' sand/dirt mix, and 2 large outdoor rings are sand mix.

GOLF CARTS/MOTORIZED SCOOTERS/ETC All operators must hold a valid Driver's License and all vehicles shall always be operated in a safe and prudent manner. The operation of any vehicle on the show grounds constitutes agreement to be bound by these provisions.

IDENTIFICATION NUMBERS Every horse will be assigned an identification number, and this number must be worn by exhibitors when the horse is being shown. Any exhibitor using a wrong number or having no number may be excused or disqualified at the Judge's discretion.

JUDGES In the event of illness or failure of a Judge to attend this show or perform his duties, the Show Committee reserves the right to substitute a judge. No contact shall be made with the Judges before or during the period of the Show unless accompanied by an EC Steward. No exhibitor has the right to inspect the Judge's cards without the Judge's permission.

LUNGING Please limit lunging to outdoor warm up areas whenever possible. NO LUNGING will be allowed indoors once the show has begun for the day until all classes are over for the day. Lunging should be done with caution and respect for ridden/driven horses.

PADDOCK INSPECTION PROCEDURE In all Regional Show Breeding and In-Hand Classes, horses will enter in an assigned order and be inspected for signs of abuse immediately prior to entrance into the ring for judging. The Order of Go shall be determined and posted by the birth date, oldest to youngest. The manner of inspection will be at the discretion of the Show Management. Any horse that does not enter the ring in his assigned order may be eliminated at the discretion of the Show Management. Judging will be done in accordance with AHA Resolution 11/06 using the "in the ring" procedure". For more information on this system, please visit the AHA website.

PARKING There are designated parking areas for cars and horse transports. Please ensure that you do not leave vehicles adjacent to barn areas where they will interfere with animals or other exhibitors' access.

P.A. SYSTEM Due to possible unforeseen problems with any mechanical device, the P.A. system and class calls over that system are considered a courtesy. The exhibitor is responsible for having his horse at the gate at the prescribed time.

PROTESTS Protest may be made to the show committee by an exhibitor, owner, agent, trainer, or the parent of a junior exhibitor for any violation of EC rules. It must be in writing, signed by the protester, addressed to the secretary of the competition at which time the alleged violation occurred; accompanied by a deposit of \$100.00. It must be received by the Steward, competition Manager or a member of the Show Committee within 48 hours of the alleged violation.

RESPONSIBILITY Region 18 Arabian Horse Show and/or the owners of the show facility will not be responsible for any article of any kind or nature that may be lost or destroyed or in any way damaged. Each exhibitor will be responsible for any injury that may be occasioned to any person or any animal, or damage to any property while on the show grounds by any horse owned or exhibited by him/her, and shall indemnify the Management against all legally established claims or damages of any kind or nature that may grow out of any injury occasioned by any horse owned or exhibited by him/her. **PRESENTATION OF THE SIGNED ENTRY FORM SHALL BE DEEMED AN ACCEPTANCE OF THESE RULES, AND ALL RULES OF EC AND AHA.**

SCHEDULE Show Management reserves the right to change and modify the schedule of events as necessary to accommodate the entries received. Any class where numbers of entries will cause overcrowding in the arena will be split upon the decision of Show Management; such splits to be announced.

SHOEING REGULATIONS See current EC rule book for shoeing requirements – Arabians 4 ¾ " toe; HA Arabians 5 ¼ " toe. Only clear material may be used on Breeding/In-Hand horses being exhibited. We reserve the right to check any horse for compliance with shoeing rules.

SMOKING RESTRICTIONS/FIRE REGULATIONS Smoking is prohibited in the barns, in the show arena, in the paddock areas or where otherwise posted. No open flames in stabling areas. No pressurized propane tanks allowed in stabling areas. No excessive accumulation of litter or rubbish. All entrances, aisles, stairways, etc. must be free and clear of obstructions. All stall curtains to be of flame-retardant material.

TOP 5 AWARDS Top 5 Awards will be made regardless of the number of entries in a class. Only awards made to the top 50% rounded up of the class will receive AHA Breeders Sweepstakes payout, AHA Horse Achievement Award, High Point Horse Achievement Award, High Point Amateur Achievement Award and Distance Award Points.

VETERINARIAN INSPECTION At the Show Committee's discretion, any animal may be subject to an examination by the show Veterinarian as a safeguard against communicable equine disease.
